We will also be running some judging exercises where we will be appraising different groups of cattle.

The event program is included.

I bring to your attention that we only have access to powered sites with shower and toilet facilities available. Competitors must come prepared to set up your own camping site.

There will be a caterer on site with all meals available for purchase. There will be a free BBQ on the last night for competitors.

This event will be governed by all COVID-19 requirements, so we are asking for a minimum of extra people attending. There will be a daily register for all people onsite and as I said if restrictions change we may also have to adjust our plans.

We look forward to seeing you this year. There will be restrictions on the number of attendees so send your entries in straight away.

This is our 30th year of running this event and the Junior Beef Committee are determined to provide participants with a great experience.

The Australian Brahman Breeders' Association will not under any circumstances, hold itself responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits or be liable for any accident or injury to competitors at the Show. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entrants must be 4 years or over and under 25 years of age as of the first day of the show (Monday 28th September, 2020). All entries under 8 years of age require a parent or guardian at all times.
2. Exhibitors to supply their own neck straps, halters, showsticks, cattle feed, water buckets, feed bins and equipment. Bedding will be supplied.
3. Entry fees: 12 years and over \$60.00 per competitor / Under 12 years \$60.00 per competitor (includes Wednesday night BBQ).
4. Camping for participants will be available at Paradise Lagoons. Full catering facilities will be available for the duration of the event.
5. Management and control of the Junior show will be in the hands of the Rockhampton Junior Beef Cattle Show Committee and all decisions will be final.
6. The Association will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused through or by any participant, and it shall be a condition of entry that each participant shall hold the Society harmless and indemnified against any legal proceedings arising from any such accident.
7. The lodgement of a completed entry form will be taken as a guarantee that the animals specified therein are free from all diseases as far as is known by the owner. In the case of an infectious disease being spread through or by an exhibit, the owner shall be held responsible.
8. Precautions will be taken to guard against fire and to protect the property at the event, but exhibits will not be insured at the cost of the Association.
9. The Association will not, under any circumstances, hold itself responsible for any loss, damage to, or misdelivery of any exhibits.
10. The Association will not, under any circumstances, hold itself liable for any accident on the ground or premises.
11. All cattle must be presented TICK FREE.
12. Strictly no Stud signs are allowed.
13. NLIS Tagging - All animals are required to carry NLIS tags before entry to the Paradise Lagoons. NLIS reading will be arranged by the Committee. Please present NVD forms to the Junior Beef Office on arrival.
14. Use of mobile phones is to be strictly limited outside the camp area for the safety of all participants, staff and animals.
